Indian Diploma in Critical Care Nursing (IDCCN)

Indian Society of Critical Care Medicine (ISCCM) is the largest association of Doctors, Nurses and other specialized health care professionals involved in caring critically ill patients.

There are various courses run by this society, IDCCN (Indian Diploma in Critical Care Nursing) is a specialized training course for nurses which helps to ameliorate and expertise with advanced skill and knowledge. The course is certified by ISCCM (Indian Society of Critical care Medicine). During the period, the nurses will be under the supervision of critical care team and nursing education team.

This course is designed to assist students in developing expertise and knowledge in the field of Critical Care Nursing. It will help students to develop advanced skills for nursing intervention in caring for critically ill patients.

Aim and Objective of the Course

At the end of the course the students will be able to:

1. Analyse and understand trends and issues related to Critical Care Nursing.
2. Describe the etiology, pathophysiology and diagnostic assessment of common critical conditions.
3. Describe the various drugs used in critical care by nurses -Responsibility in their administration.
4. Demonstrate advanced skills/competencies in managing critically ill patients including Advance Cardiac Life Support.
5. Demonstrate skill in handling various equipment used in ICU.
6. Do pain assessment and management.
7. Identify complications & take appropriate measures.
8. Support patients and their family to cope with emotional distress, grief and anxiety
9. Assist in various diagnostic, therapeutic and surgical procedures
10. Identify the sources of stress and manage burnout syndrome among health care providers.
11. Design a layout of ICU and develop standards for critical care nursing practice.
12. Provide quality care to critically ill patients.
13. Teach nurses, allied health professionals and family members about areas related to critical care nursing.

- **Duration:** 1 year + 1 Year Internship
- **No. of seats:** 4
- **Academic Requirement:** Pass in GNM/BSc Nursing/Post BSc/MSc Nursing with at least 50% marks.
- **Mode of Selection:** On the basis of marks scored for GNM/BSc Nursing/Post BSc/MSc Nursing and in the qualifying examination and personal interview.
